**Routes:** All rides head west through Belmont to Concord. The 35-mile ride returns to Harvard University from Concord. The 75-mile ride continues to Harvard, Massachusetts, before returning. All routes are fully marked with designated water and food stops. The majority of roads are backcountry and very scenic. A map and cue sheet will be provided for each rider.

**Terrain:** The 35-mile loop is rolling with only modest climbs. The 75-mile loop involves a steady climb into Harvard, MA.

**Support:** Food and water are available at the start of the ride and at designated locations in Concord and Harvard. There are numerous convenience stores and gas stations along the route; riders may bring cash for lunch. Each loop will be patrolled by a sag wagon carrying a floor pump, tubes, tools, water and minimal first-aid. Members of the Harvard University Cycling Association will be riding each loop as designated ride leaders.

**Directions** to the Murr Center, 65 North Harvard Street, Boston, MA 02163:

From the west: Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90) east to Exit 18 (Allston/Cambridge). After paying toll, bear left at fork towards Allston. Turn right at second set of lights onto North Harvard Street. Proceed approximately 1 mile to Harvard Stadium entrance on your left.

From the north: Take I-93 south to Storrow Drive exit. Take Storrow Drive west for approximately 5 miles. Exit at Harvard Square/North Harvard Street. At top of ramp, turn left onto North Harvard Street. The Harvard stadium entrance is approximately 1/4 mile on your ride.

From the south: Take I-95 north to I-93 north. Follow I-93 until Exit 20 (Mass Turnpike). Take Mass Pike west to Exit 20 (Allston/Cambridge). After paying toll, bear left at fork towards Allston. Turn right at second set of lights onto North Harvard Street. Proceed approximately 1 mile to Harvard Stadium entrance on your left.
