



Submit Original High School/Undergraduate Research to the Journal of Undergraduate Sciences

- Submissions for the Summer 1999 High School Issue should be postmarked by June 1, 1999 for best chances for consideration. Submissions received after this deadline may be automatically considered for the Winter 2000 issue, unless the author indicates otherwise in writing.
- Submissions for the Fall 2000 College Issue should be postmarked by August 1, 1999. Submissions received after the deadline will be automatically considered for publication in the Spring 2000 issue.
- A summer address is necessary for submissions in the months of April through August; if this address is presently unknown, the permanent address will be used for correspondence during the summer until you have either email your summer address to jus@hcs.harvard.edu or send a postcard with this information to the Journal's address given below.
- Please do not forget to include (or attach) a brief abstract/summary not exceeding 250 words with your submission; a **submission without an abstract will be regarded as incomplete.**
- Please submit **one hard copy** of your paper as well as **one copy on diskette** (the preferred formats are MS Word if you are a Macintosh user; MS Word or PageMaker if you are a PC or Windows user). Except in special circumstances, **failure to submit all of these items will result in your submission being regarded as incomplete and receiving low priority in the review process.**
